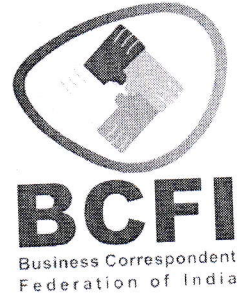

Subject - Support in functioning of Business Correspondents (BCs)/Bank Mitras Implementing Government Schemes viz PMJDY and Direct Benefit Transfers of Government to Citizens

Dear Sir,

Reference Ministry of Home Affairs Order No 40-3/2020-DM-1(A) Dated March 25, 2020 (Copy attached).

Business Correspondents (BC) are serving to implement various government schemes like PMJDY, bringing awareness against COVID - 19 and playing a crucial role of partnership in ensuring availability of essential banking services including Direct Benefit Transfers from government announced recently to citizens across India in the time of stress, through their network of BCs /Bank Mitras. In spite of unusual situation arising out of COVID-19, the BCs/Bank Mitras have acted swiftly to continue implementation of Government Schemes/Direct Benefit Transfer of money to needy citizens and provide uninterrupted services to the unbanked/underbanked areas pan-India.

In view of current situation, the BCs are taking all necessary precautionary measures to protect the customers and themselves while providing essential services and Direct Benefit Transfers announced by the government recently.

In view of the aforesaid, it is requested that BCs be permitted to operate and function 24/7, since they are providing essential banking services including Direct Benefit Transfers from government announced recently to citizens across India at this crucial juncture. You are also requested to kindly issue necessary instructions to concerned departments/authorities in this regard so that BCs are allowed to function uninterrupted as per Ministry of Home Affairs order mentioned above.
